Managing Critics Like A Pro

At a recent IT conference, Tony Hawk, skateboard legend, successful CEO of Birdhouse Skateboards and partner in the billion-dollar video game franchise Pro Skater was the keynote speaker. He is an athlete, storyteller, brand builder, entertainer, philanthropist, and probably the coolest person we have ever met. More importantly, he had some great insights for business leaders on how to deal with critics. By staying focused on what he was doing, ignoring the noise, and opting out of the toxic narratives, Hawk answered his critics with his own truth and is arguably one of the most successful in his industry.

He was 9 years old when his brother gave him his first skateboard and by 14 he had turned pro. By 16 he was widely considered the best skateboarder in the world, and he was known by millions. In 1999 he became the first skater to ever complete the 900.

"I can't say that I was a natural but I really enjoyed the challenge." Hawk explained that it was perseverance, determination, and hard work that got him to be good at skating. That is passion. Once he got good it was the desire to see what was next that got him to be great. He began creating his own moves and challenging himself beyond everything he had learned. That is doing something new. The critics had much to say about it. Even before social media, Hawk had considerable experience with critics. "I've had a lot of haters through the decades" says Hawk.

At first, he was criticized for his style. Older pros even accused him of cheating. He got criticism from his "elders" in the magazines, and other pros. This was at a time when skateboarding was the outcast of sports. Hawk found himself being the outcast within the outcast. He would even get booed and called a "cheat" for his "circus tricks" on the board. He learned to ignore the noise and focus on his passion.



In later years, after he'd become the single most winning skateboarding champion of all time, critics said he was ONLY winning because his father was involved in the competitions. Later, when he got sponsorships and endorsement deals, he was criticized for being a "sell-out."

While he still has haters, he is a huge success. The Hawk empire includes Birdhouse Skateboards, Hawk clothing, Tony Hawk signature series products as well as his production company, 900 films. He was featured in an HBO documentary title Tony Hawk Until The Wheels Fall Off by the award-winning director Sam Jones. Hawk founded The Skate Park Project which helps underserved communities create safe and inclusive skate parks for youth.

You are probably familiar with the famous quote:

To avoid criticism, say nothing, do nothing, be nothing.

If you do not have any critics, you may not be doing anything worth talking about. Don't misunderstand, you do NOT have to "just take it" when someone bullies you, threatens you, insults you or criticizes you. In some cases, you can ignore it. Even if you choose to punch back, and sometimes you must, you still have to stay focused on doing what you do well. Learn to identify the noise, opt out of the toxic dialogues, and answer your critics with your own success.

Memorial Day: The Most Dramatic Salute

Few tributes are as moving as the traditional flyover at a military funeral or important public event. The flyover is even more dramatic when one aircraft zooms out of formation in the Missing Man Salute.

The missing man formation evolved from early flyovers. The first non-military flyover was in 1936 for King George V. The first U.S. flyover was in 1938, when 50 aircraft honored Major General Oscar Westover, flying with one empty space. By the end of World War II, the formation included the pull-up, when one plane flies out of formation, sometimes to the setting sun.

The formation is usually flown by four to six aircraft in a V formation. The flight leader is at the point of the arrowhead. As the formation approaches the gravesite or ceremonial area, the wingman following to the leader's right leaves the formation in a spectacular pull-up, suggesting the hero's soul going up to God.

The U.S. Navy Blue Angels are famous for their dramatic flyovers, including their missing man formations.
